

A.), has undertaken the first complete translation of the works of Saint Augustine. The first electronic release contained 20 volumes of the printed series. The second electronic release, with an additional 10 volumes, contained 30 volumes of the projected 50 volumes of the printed series. The third release, with an additional five volumes, contains 35 volumes of the printed series. The fourth release, with an additional 6 volumes including *The City of God*, contained 41 volumes of the printed series. This fifth release, with an additional 4 volumes, contains 45 volumes of the printed series.

In Geneva: [1780]-1782 & 1789. Complete in 17 vols. Famous edition published by the Société typographique de Genève, containing the first part of the Confessions in the original edition. The text was established by Pierre Moulton and Du Peyrou. Edition printed simultaneously in three formats, the in-4 edition being the most prestigious. The 15 vols. were completed in 1789 by 2 additional vols. containing the second part of the Confessions.

The French was originally digitized by the library at the University of Geneva. Every page of the searchable text is linked to the image of the page in the original 18th century edition.

In addition, on an experimental basis, we have created a Google AI translation into English of all 17 volumes. Each page of the English translation is linked to the French of Rousseau (and vice-versa). While the English translation is not perfect, it can be used as a basis for searches, and the translation demonstrates how far AI translation has evolved.
